The indoor vendor area will be open from 5p.m. to 9p.m. Friday, 10a.m. to 9p.m. Saturday, and 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. Sunday. It will be locked at all other times. The grounds will be patrolled by security personnel.

Vendor setup time is on Thursday 10a.m. - 5p.m. Friday 10a.m. - 5p.m.

We encourage all work to be handcrafted by the vendor. Manufactured items must be approved prior to the event.

All exhibitors will receive free camping with access to flush toilets and showers. Electricity is available at some campsites on a first come basis for \$30 for the weekend. This festival is held at rural fairgrounds with lots of shaded campsites. A lot of the vendor space has shade and most vendors can camp adjacent to their booths.
