Vendor setup time is Thursday from 10a.m.-5p.m. All booths must remain open until 4p.m. Sunday, no exceptions.

All exhibitors will receive free camping with access to flush toilets and showers. Electricity is available at some campsites on a first come basis for \$30 for the weekend.
